



## Suck Mountain Shelter – Directions to Site

Forest Road 149 goes from highway 27 north of Story west / southwest to Sims. Route from Sims is the best with only 4.8 miles of gravel on FR 149 to shelter turn.

From Sims – Highway 88:	Miles / Cuml.
Take paved rd. Sims Loop Rd. east just north of fire station	2.0 m/2.0 m
To gravel	
End of pavement to intersection with FR 149 (Rainy Cr. Rd.)	.4 m/2.4 m
Stay left	
FR 149 to crossing of Ouachita Trail	1.0 m/3.4 m
From OT cross Rainy Creek then stay right	.3 m/3.7 m
Next intersection stay left	.1 m/3.8 m
Shelter turn off on right top of hill, flagged (7.2 miles)	3.4 m/7.2 m

From Story – Highway 27:	
Story north to FR 149 / Muddy Creek Wildlife Refuge	1.9 m/1.9 m
West to Muddy Creek Bridge	2.5 m/4.4 m
Stay on FR 149 / Intersection stay right at	4.5 m/8.9 m
Shelter turn off on left top of hill, flagged (11.5 miles)	3.4 m/11.5 m

FoOT will have volunteers to direct traffic & provide shuttle service from the new road. Can drive 1/3 mile up Forest Road past pipe gate off FR 149 to where new road has been pushed out to shelter. Trucks can drive this new road or any vehicle with some clearance. Suck Mtn. Shelter is located 2/3 mile south up the new road. Mostly level with one small grade. Room to park and turn around at the site. Rain could make the approach a little more difficult.
