

Installation of replacement sign posts and signs for Ouachita Trail:

Contact FoOT signmaker with what is needed for the replacement sign. Provide a photo or exact text of what is needed.

You will need:

The new sign (unless old one is good).

4X4 treated post. You may ask your Ranger District to provide one; purchase and donate one yourself; or check with FoOT Treasurer prior to purchase to see if you can be reimbursed for the cost.

Cut it off to approximately 6 ½ to 7 ft. length. Cut the top at an angle for proper water shedding. You will need to have 2 ft. in the ground.

At least two lag bolts 5/16 X 4.5”.

A ratchet and socket or a wrench to take on the trail.

A cordless drill to make the pilot hole in the post out on the trail.

Something to dig the hole with.

Pre-drill the sign board at home. Do not pre-drill the post at home since you will not be able to match them up out on the trail. You will drill the pilot holes after the post is set in the ground and then attach the sign.
